

Oiled Floor Care Guide

GENERAL TIPS

Place protective felt under all furniture legs, both stationary and moveable furniture

Clean up spills as quickly as possible

Never place plants directly on your floor, use a waterproof tray

Never use all purpose cleaners or steam mops on your hardwood floors

Daily Care	Weekly/Bi-Weekly Care	Yearly Care
<p>Vacuum, Sweep or dust mop regularly to remove loose dirt and debris</p> <p>Damp microfiber mop as needed</p> <p>Never soak floors or leave standing water</p>	<p>Wash your floor with Bona cleaner</p> <p>Dilute product as specified on bottle. Dample the mp or spray lightly on floor and clean with microfiber mop</p> <p>Do not soak floor or leave standing water</p> <p>Do not scrub with an abrasive brush or pad</p> <p>High traffic areas may require more frequent washing</p>	<p>Inspect floor every 6-12 months for signs of wear. Contact us wtih any questions or concerns.</p> <p>Dull marks and wear at high traffic spots are normal</p> <p>Refreshing the oil finish may be needed every so often. Contact us to schedule a re-oil for your floors. This is typical every 2 years.</p>
